KAEDY'S SLIGHTLY SPICY NO-VODKA PASTA

Serves 2 - pairs well with a night of folk & friends

INGREDIENTS:

8oz pasta of choice

1/4 cup olive oil

1/2 tbsp minced garlic

1 1/2 cup tomato paste

3/4 cup heavy cream

Red pepper flakes

Basil

Salt & pepper

1/4 cup grated parmesan

1/4 cup pasta water

1 tbsp butter

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cook pasta to package instructions.

Save a smidge of pasta water!

2. In a saucepan, add olive oil & garlic

over medium heat. Add tomato paste

& cook for 4-5 minutes.

3. Add heavy cream & combine well!

Simmer for 2-3 minutes.

4. Add Red pepper flakes, basil, salt,

& pepper to taste. Give it a mix.

5. Add Grated parmesan, butter,

& pasta water. Mix once again.

6. Toss in cooked pasta and mix

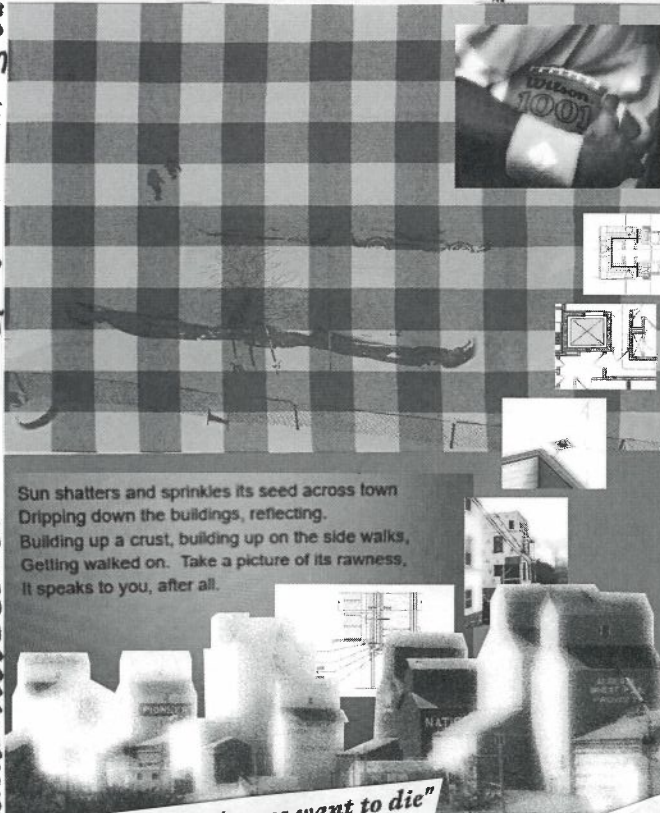
it up. Top it off with more
